## Psalms 27:14

That kind of thinking implies that God is not in control or is not fair. But God is worth waiting for. Lamentations 3:24-26 calls us to hope in and wait for the Lord. God often uses time of waiting to refresh, renew and teach us. Make good use of your waiting times by discovering what God may be trying to do in you while you are in them.
